Johnny Atley (deceased) Class of 1935. He earned 16 varsity letters in baseball, basketball, football and track and field. No other athlete has ever earned more letters in the history of Milford High School. Former Hall of Fame coach, Wayne Webb (deceased) was quoted in an early Milford Times article as saying Johnny was the greatest athlete in the early days of Milford High. Johnny was the captain of the football team for three years and captain of the basketball team for one. He led Milford to its first conference title in both football and track and field. After graduation, Johnny was a member of the GM Parade of Progress which toured the country with the latest developments in automotive technology. Johnny passed away in 1997.
