Lori Montante was an outstanding athlete in volleyball, basketball, and softball. She was a first team All-League selection in each sport, an accomplishment rarely achieved by an athlete. She earned 11 varsity letters during her career at Milford High.

An outstanding basketball player, she led her team to the 1988 KVC and District titles. She holds four school records: most assists in one game (10), most assists in one season (84), highest free-throw percentage in a season (88%), and most free-throws made in a career (524). In addition to these records, she is also the second leading career scorer with 1,788 points. A four-time All-KVC selection in basketball, including three first team awards, Lori Montante helped Milford to one of its most successful eras in women's basketball. Her scoring records are even more meaningful considering that the three point shot wasn't instituted until her senior year.

Lori was also a four-time All-KVC and two-time All-Area selection in volleyball as well as two-time All-KVC selection in softball.

After high school, Montante attended Oakland Community College and Oakland University where she competed in basketball and majored in education.

Lori is now a teacher at Novi Middle School. She and her husband, Andy, reside in Highland with twins Kamryn and Riley.
