- HHC play ramps up this week with seven conference games, including one between early leaders New Palestine and Yorktown on Tuesday. Greenfield-Central and Pendleton Heights will both play their first conference games this week, as well. Other key games include Shelbyville at Pendleton Hts. (Tuesday), Greenfield-Central at New Castle and rivals Yorktown at Delta (Wednesday) and Mt. Vernon at New Palestine (Thursday).
- Pendleton Heights swept its way to the Madison County Tournament title, beating Madison-Grant 1-0 in the title game. Audrey Ricker threw a one-hit shutout with seven strikeouts in the championship game.
- MaKenzie Gee of Mt. Vernon hit her second grand slam of the year last week, and hit for the cycle on the week with four singles, a double and a triple, driving in eight runs.
- New Castle's Cameron Tabor had a hot week, going 8-13 with three homers and 10 RBI in four games.
- New Palestine remains No. 1 in Class 3A, tied with Lebanon. Yorktown is ranked No. 10. In Class 4A, both Greenfield-Central and Pendleton Heights are receiving votes.
