

2015 Fairfield County Fair

Does October 10th through the 17th ring any bells? Those are the dates of the Fairfield County Fair! Yes, you guessed it, this is from the Liberty Union Fair Booth and we are asking you for your help *again!*

The dates are rapidly approaching and we will need your help to make 2015 another successful year! We know busy schedules make it difficult to volunteer, but with many shifts available along with the ability to sign up online, it is our hope that it makes it a little easier to accommodate the busiest of schedules.

In order for the fair booth to run efficiently, we need at least 10 adult volunteers and 10 student volunteers per shift. Juniors and one of their parents are asked to work **TWO** shifts each. Any athlete or music member and one of their parents are asked to work **ONE** shift each.

The Adult Shifts are as follows:

Saturday, October 10th
8am - 1pm 1pm - 6pm

Sunday, October 11th
9am - 1:30pm 1:30pm - 6pm

Monday, October 12th thru Saturday, October 17th
6am - 10am 10am - 2pm 2pm - 6pm 6pm - Close

The students can sign up for their shifts at school with the Junior Class Advisor.

Please, we ask that you set aside some time out of your busy, growing schedules to help us, help our children and community out. We cannot do this without you!

If you are unable to volunteer your time, we do accept some various food donations. We ask for pies, cookie bars, and some miscellaneous condiments for the booth. A complete list of what is needed is available online.

- 3) Search by e-mail "lufair@columbus.rr.com", then (for security) solve the simple puzzle.
- 4) Select the sign up you wish to volunteer. (Fair Booth or Food Donations)
- 5) Enter the access code "2223", then click submit.
- 6) From there, sign up for what works best for you.
