HALL OF FAME RULES OF ELIBILITY

No athlete may be admitted until he or she has been graduated for at least ten years.

Eligible nominees shall include any participant in any varsity interscholastic sport at Gilbert High School or any supporter of varsity athletics that the committee deems worthy of recognition.

Also, any coach, manager, sports personality (writer, broadcaster), booster club member, trainer, medical doctor, cheerleader, press booth announcer, photographer, teacher, administrator and any other person the nominations committee deems worthy of membership shall be eligible.

Nominations must be made in writing.

Anyone may submit a nomination, but must identify themselves.
