### **GATEWAY HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC AND ACTIVITIES ELIGIBILITY POLICY 2017-2018**

*All students that are participating in athletics, band, orchestra, choir, STUCO and theatre must meet the following criteria to be able to participate in games and events.*

- *if Students must be in class 95% of the time.*
- **IF A STUDENT HAS AN UNEXCUSED ABSENCE THEY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN GAMES OR ACTIVITIES**
- *Students cannot participate they have 2 F's. Two D's equals an F – therefore if you have 4 D's you cannot participate*

*If a student does not meet the criteria, they will be **ineligible to participate** in games and activities that have been planned for the following two weeks.*

*For example, the first day of school is August 8. Teachers will need to have their grades current for that **two week cycle** by August 22. The new **two week cycle** would then start. The yearly expectation for teachers is to update their gradebook every two weeks on Mondays by 4:00pm. If a student did not meet the attendance and academic requirements they will be ineligible for the following two weeks.*
