Giving a gift=Tax Deduction



*The Findlay Athletic Department and Trojan Athletic Booster Club would like to extend to you an opportunity to provide a **tax deductible** donation for the students and future of our programs here in Findlay. The most valuable donation you can give is your time, however, we welcome all levels of donation, whether it's a one-time gift or periodically. With this opportunity on behalf of the Findlay High School Athletic Department and the Findlay Trojan Club we appreciate your generous gift. On behalf of the students and coaches of Findlay High we appreciate your generous gift.*

Trojan Club:

- As a general guideline, the Trojan Club's mission supports all athletic programs. Therefore, cash donations may be split 80 – 20. Meaning 80% of your cash donation will be earmarked towards a specific sport while the additional money will go to the upgrade of athletics facilities that will benefit the desired athletic program.
- As the donor I would like to contribute a cash donation to the Trojan Club for the support of all the athletes at Findlay High School.
- As the donor I would like to make a direct donation of a specific item to the Trojan Club. I understand that with making a direct donation of equipment contributed to the school becomes the property of the District and is subject to the same controls and regulations that govern the use of other school-owned property.

Athletic Department:

- As the donor I understand the Findlay City School Board Policy of Public Gifts to Schools. Items include:
Gifts which serve to enhance and extend the work of the schools may be received by the District. It shall be the general policy to direct those who desire to make contribution to consider equipment or services that are not likely to be acquired from Public Fund Expenditures.
1. Contributions of equipment or services that may involve major costs for installation or maintenance, or initial or continuing financial commitments from school funds shall be presented by the Superintendent's office for Board consideration and approval.
 2. Individuals or organizations desiring to contribute supplies or equipment will counsel with school officials regarding the acceptability of such contributions in advance of the solicitation of funds or the making of budgetary appropriations.
 3. A monetary donation, preferably via check: Money given to the school cannot be ear marked for any particular request. The gift of cash or valuable consideration would be up to the district to use at its discretion. However, the Findlay City Board of Education will attempt to honor your request.
 4. Donation must be approved through Findlay City Board of Education.
