FRESHMAN YEAR

- Take the PSAT in October.
- Meet with guidance department prior to registration for sophomore year to discuss:
 - College entrance requirements
 - Course requirement for make-up courses
- Work to maintain GPA minimum of 2.5
- Engage in multiple sports throughout the school year
- Log community service hours
- Strive to be a “PRIDE Student Athlete”
- Complete player profile

SOPHOMORE YEAR

- Take the PSAT in October
- IHSAA student advisory Committee referral
- Meet with guidance department prior to registration for junior year to discuss:
 - College entrance requirements
 - Course requirement for make-up courses
- Work to maintain GPA of 2.5
- Engage in multiple sports throughout the school year
- Log community service hours
- Strive to be a “PRIDE Student Athlete”
- Update player profile

JUNIOR YEAR

- Take the SAT or ACT in the spring.
- Take the College Board Accuplacer
- Meet with guidance department before registration for senior year to be sure you meet college admission requirements and NCAA eligibility rules.
- Meet with your head coach to discuss your potential to play college athletics at the divisions I, II, and III; NAIA; and junior college levels
- Research and attend scholarship and junior invite days with different institutions with parent.
- Strive to be a “PRIDE Student Athlete”
- Log community services hours
- Update player profile

SENIOR YEAR

- Register with the NCAA eligibility Center if Division I or II.
- Register with the NAIA eligibility center for NAIA athletics.
- Retake the SAT and/or the ACT if necessary.
- Meet with the guidance and athletic director early in the fall to review your transcript and NCAA eligibility rules.
- Meet with your head coach to discuss your plan for college athletics and at what level.
- Apply to selected Divisions I, II, and III; NAIA; and junior college.
- Strive to be a “PRIDE Student Athlete”
- Log community service hours
- Take official college
- Complete FAFSA application
