Vose Contemporary Realism is pleased to present an exhibition of exquisite works by the esteemed Boston-area pastel artist, Janet Monafo. In this, her first solo-show in her hometown, Monafo expands upon an already impressive exhibition history that includes shows at such venues as the J. Cacciola Gallery, Hollis Taggart Gallery, and Sherry French Gallery, all of New York City. A nationally recognized artist with a long list of accolades, Monafo was elected this year into the Pastel Society of America's Hall of Fame, an honor also held by William Merrit Chase and Mary Cassatt.

The art of pastel painting is enjoying a renaissance as more and more viewers appreciate the luscious colors and light effects rendered in this medium. Frequently thought of as fragile, pastels are actually the most permanent of painting materials and will not fade, yellow, crack or blister with time or exposure to light, as do other mediums. Pastel is pure pigment rolled into sticks using a small amount of binding medium; when applied to conservation paper and properly framed, works in pastel can, and have, lasted for centuries. With new glazing materials that practically eliminate glare, pastels can take their place alongside paintings in any medium.

Janet Monafo's virtuosity in pastel can be seen in the striking effects of her elaborately arranged still lifes, and the range of her of talent extends to her highly expressive figural works. We are sure that our friends and clients who view Monafo's work will think the title—*Brilliant*—is an understatement!




