"We currently use four different laser wavelengths to augment our cosmetic dentistry procedures, on almost every patient we treat." Sedation dentistry is also a very popular adjunct used to enhance the overall patient experience. "We incorporate the latest, safest procedures and treatments here in our office, reflecting our steadfast commitment to up-and-coming developments in the field of cosmetic dentistry," says Dr. Broome.
