## The Word of God and the God Who IS the Word

Never lose sight of this - the way a person treats Scripture is a reflection of how they treat Jesus. Just as the way a person treats the church is a reflection of how one treats Jesus (Acts 8:3; 9:4), so it is with how we view the Bible and Christ. If we ignore and neglect Scripture, we also ignore and are guilty of neglecting Jesus. If we love Jesus, we'll love His word.

Do not misunderstand the point: I am NOT saying the Word (Jesus) and the word of God (Scripture) are perfectly synonymous; One is Deity, the other is divine communication. I AM saying the relationship that exists between Jesus and His word is marvelously inter-related, unified and powerful. Just as God spoke the world into creation by speaking (Genesis 1:3 et al), it is through Jesus and His word that God "speaks" the message of salvation (Hebrews 1:1-4). Consider just a few traits Jesus the "Word" and the word of God (Scripture) share.

Jesus Is God (the Word) Incarnate (John 1:1, 14), while Scripture Is God's Word Inspired – In Written Form (2 Timothy 3:16-17).

Jesus Is Holy (Luke 1:35) and Word of God is too (Romans 1:1-2; 2 Timothy 3:15).

Jesus Is the Light of the World (John 8:12; 9:5-6) and Scripture is Light to Guide Us while We are in the World (Psalm 119:105, 130).

Jesus Is Life and Gives Life (John 11:25; 14:6), while the Bible Has Life and Tells Us How to Have Life In God (Hebrews 4:12; Philippians 2:16).

Jesus Is Eternal (John 1:1-2), and So Is the Word of God (Psalm 119:89; Matthew 24:35).

Jesus Is Righteous (2 Timothy 4:8; 1 John 2:1), and the Bible Displays the Same Attribute (Psalm 19:7; 119:160; Romans 7:12).

Jesus Is the Way and the Truth (John 14:6); so is Scripture (Jeremiah 6:16; 10:23; John 17:17; Ephesians 1:13).

Jesus Is to be Loved and Obeyed (John 14:15; 15:9-10), while so Is Scripture (Psalm 119:47-48; Luke 6:46).

Jesus Is to be Delighted and Rejoiced In (Psalm 37:4; 1 John 1:1-4). So Is the Word of God (Psalm 1:2; 1 John 1:4).

Jesus Is to "Dwell" in Us (Galatians 2:20; Colossians 1:27) and the Word of God Is to "Dwell" In Us Too (Matthew 4:4; Colossians 3:16).

Is there any disconnect in your life concerning the God who IS the Word and the Word of God?
