

As we bring this current set of sermons to a close, I would like to offer up some points of prominence. One, the Great God of Heaven will never accept the least from us; only our best (Lev I:3, NKJV). Two, Our Heavenly Father is Lord of ALL...not just some (Jer 10:10). He is Just (Gen 18:25), Supreme (Deut. 32:4), Triune (Gen. I:26), and Sinless (James I:13). David surmised God "is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer" (Psa 18:2a). He is The Living God!

Why is this important today? One word...truth. God manifested Himself in the flesh and walked among men for a time (Jn 1:14). We called Him Jesus. The fulfillment of God's promise to save mankind would be completed at Calvary (Gen 3:15, Lk 23:23). Christ's disciples were assured of this by the angel's statement, "Why do you seek the living among the dead? He is not here, but is risen!" (Lk 24:5b-6a). Every first day of the week, New Testament Christians come together to serve the Lord. They are reminded of the Lord's goodness and mercy in the sacrificing of Jesus by the taking of the communion (1 Cor 11:26).

Many still inquire, "Who is the LORD, that I should obey His voice to let Israel go?" to their own detriment (Ex 5:2b). We beg you not to be among them. Rather, we encourage you to ask the question, "Lord, to whom shall we go?" (John 6:68b). Answer: The Living God!
