On October 5th 2017 at Creekside at the Wenger Family Homestead, 100 Women came together to invest in improvement of the lives of homeless women through the work of the Women's Shelter on Willow in Lebanon. With The Wenger Foundation and Ambassador Advisors as hosts, the community of women came to support and to learn about the shelter and to hear the testimony of Shannon, who has a leadership role at the shelter having come out of homelessness through a similar program.
