



Scope of Work for Graduate Student Internship Fall 2020

- Title:** **Global WASH Intern** at iDE
- Scope:** [iDE](#) creates income and livelihood opportunities for poor rural households through a market-based approach to development. The [Global WASH Initiative](#) implements water, sanitation, and hygiene (WASH) programs in six countries in Asia and Africa. iDE has been researching, designing, and scaling sustainable sanitation enterprises around the developing world for the last ten years. To date, we have sold over one million toilets and 600,000 water filters across Cambodia, Bangladesh, Vietnam, Nepal, Ethiopia and Ghana.
- The Global WASH team, based out of the Denver office, offers technical and strategic support across the global portfolio. This team seeks a graduate student to provide general and programmatic support. Specific responsibilities include:
- *Research and Analysis* - Perform ongoing and ad hoc analysis for iDE's WASH programs and contribute to the evolution of our analytical models. This may include literature reviews, annotated bibliographies, and case studies.
 - *Business Development* - Support on live bids and in developing materials for strategic partners.
 - *Strategy Development* - Support development of program strategies for emerging areas of work; contribute to tactical reviews and case studies aimed at improving project intervention models.
 - Other support functions as agreed upon with your supervisor, including writing abstracts for conference submissions and summarizing key findings from relevant sector webinars.
- Coordinator:** This position reports to **the Global WASH Innovation and Performance Manager**, who will act as Coordinator for the Intern. The Coordinator will meet regularly with the Intern and will guide their work with iDE.
- Hours:** We are looking for an individual who is able to commit **15 - 20 hours per week** to iDE over the term of the internship.
- Assignment Dates:** We are looking for an intern/fellow to join **late August or early September 2020** and will likely end **mid-December**, at a mutually agreed upon date



based on Intern availability and Global WASH need for support. There is a possibility of extension given interest by both the Intern and Global WASH.

Compensation:

We do not have internal funding available for this position at this time. If the applicant is enrolled in university and can access funding, we are happy to support the application and necessary paperwork that may be needed.
