Healing as a Part of Hypnosis

A presentation by Betty Alice Erickson, MS, LPC, LMFT

Ms. Erickson, an international presenter on Ericksonian therapy and hypnosis, will discuss the role of healing in hypnotherapy. She will discuss how healing is a change in the person from within, "sometimes without conscious understanding." She maintains that since hypnosis speaks to the unconscious, it can be an excellent tool for this process. She will demonstrate and teach on clarifying both direct and indirect methods of creating healing through hypnosis, and how to construct a trance with components of healing. This presentation is based on her recent book with Bradford Keeney: Milton H. Erickson, An American Healer.
