Taking the long view through the Johari Window  
Deborah Beckman, M.S.

Ms. Beckman will give a presentation on The Johari Window, which was developed by Joseph Luff, Ph.D. and Harry Ingham, Ph.D., and which provides an organizational view of the self. She will discuss how the format of the Johari Window can be combined with the strategic use of hypnosis and specific trance language (that has been tailored to the client's individual needs) to provide a rich source of therapeutic interventions.

This presentation will include a demonstration, along with case presentations, as well as discussion on crafting a variety of possible interventions.
