This unique look is achieved by hand finishing and age patinating to our own formula, in a four stage process, which when completed effects the look akin to old weathered garden ornament. Architectural Heritage's age patinated artificial stone ornament is well suited for water features due to its strength and resilience in extreme temperatures.
