Methodology

Seven-minute online survey Independent Panel 768 total responses US residents

18 years old or older

Currently using a smartphone or tablet





- Scratches on the screen or body of the device are the most common form of damage, but are among the least concerning to users.
- Smartphone and tablet users' greatest concern is that their device may be lost or stolen.
- In terms of damage, a dropped phone/ tablet is the top concern. Users are particularly worried about cracking / breaking their screen as the result of a drop.
- 48% of smartphone users and 27% of tablet users are currently using a damaged smartphone or tablet respectively.

"I'll lose it when the battery is low and won't" be able to locate it."


"That I'd lose it or have it stolen."

"Dropping it and having the screen shatter."


"I'm worried that it will fall on the ground and break."

What are you most worried will happen to your smartphone?*




Scratches are by far the most prevalent form of smartphone damage.

Of smartphone users who had damaged a smartphone, almost two fifths (38%) reported their most recent cause of damage as a drop or fall. One

"I was grocery shopping and my phone fell out of my coat pocket as I was reaching for milk."


"Tried to talk on the phone while getting out of the tub and dropped it in some water."

"I was getting into the car and it fell out and dropped right on the corner and cracked the screen."

"I was taking a shower and my young son threw it in the shower."


Almost half of smartphone users (49%) with damaged phones ended up either repairing or replacing their phones.

After your smartphone was damaged, what did you do?





How much did the smartphone repair/ replacement cost?




Just under half (48%) of all smartphone users are currently using a damaged smartphone. Roughly the same number are using phone cases.


What protective products do you use with your smartphone?





Tablet users are much less concerned about their tablets than smartphone users are about their phones. Loss of the device is still the top concern.


"I'm worried that I might drop it and break it."

"Battery will get worse and worse! Not keep a charge!"


"Not much. It never leaves the house."

Scratches are the most prevalent form of tablet damage. 70% of tablet users claim to have never damaged a tablet.



Of tablet owners who have damaged a tablet, almost one third (32%)recently dropped their tablet.




"My toddler was playing with it and she cracked the screen as she was trying to get up."


"Scratched when it was dragged across the floor."

Over two-thirds of tablet users with a damaged tablet don't take any action after their tablet is damaged.


After your smartphone was damaged, what did you do?
