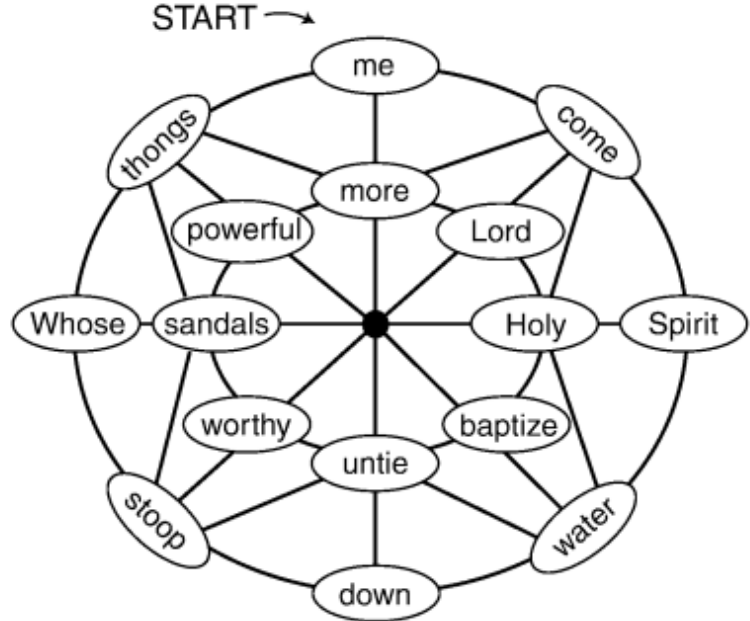
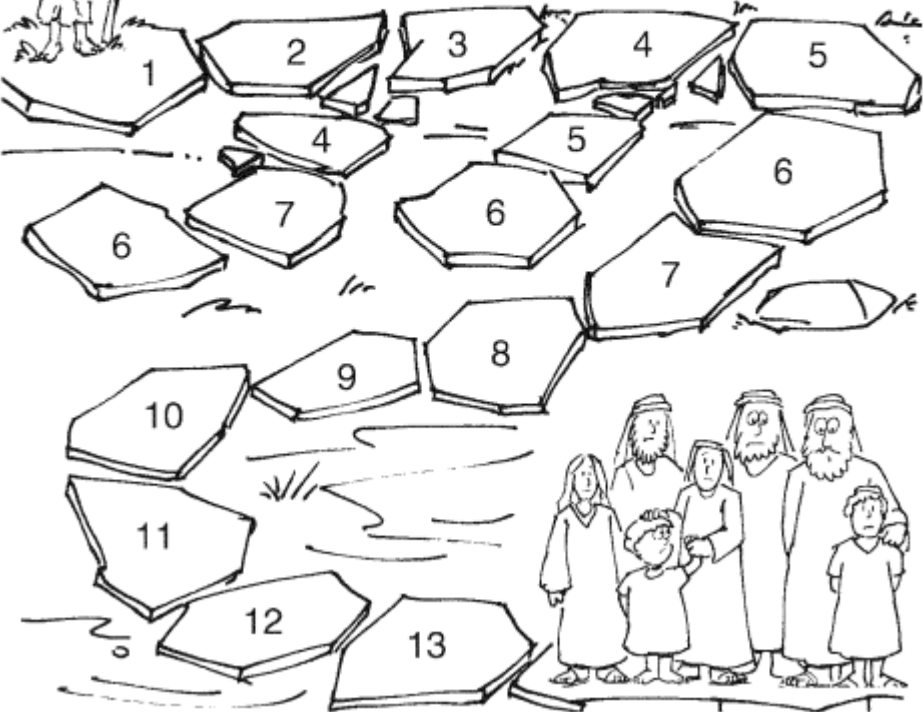


John spoke about the Lord.
