Q: What did God threaten in the covenant of life?

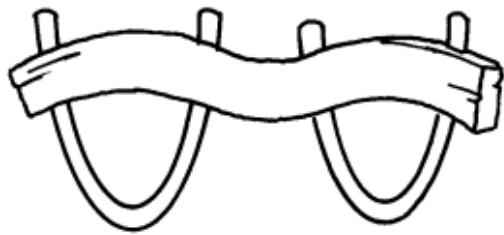
A: To punish Adam with death if he disobeyed God.
