Prelude

God Calls Us to Glorify and Enjoy Him

Salutation

*Call to Worship

God invites us into his presence and calls us to worship him.

*Hymn— **101 "Come, Thou Almighty King"**

We respond to God's call by singing praises to him.

*Invocation

We ask God to accept our worship through Christ.

God Hears Our Prayer of Confession

Call to Confession: **Romans 3: 23 (p. 941)**

We confess to God that he is holy and we have fallen short of his standard.

Prayer of Confession:

Holy God, we confess that we have sinned against you by what we have thought, by what we have said and by what we have done. We recognize that our sin has separated us from you and we fully deserve the wages of our sin which is eternal death. By the power of your Spirit, help us to turn from our sin, and receive and rest upon Christ alone for our salvation.

(silent confession)

Assurance of Forgiveness: **Romans 6:23 (p. 943)**

God assures us of the grace and forgiveness that is found in Christ alone.

We respond to God's overflowing grace with praise.

God Unites Us in Doctrine and Prayer

*Pew Bible Reading— **Selection 20 His Steadfast Love (p. 1054)**

God's word teaches us about himself and is used to encourage each other.

Reading of Scripture— **Psalm 110: 1-7 (p. 509)**

God uses his word to help us to grow in our understanding of Christ.

Congregational Prayer

We respond to God's word by bringing him our praises and concerns.

Collection for the Saints

We respond to God's generosity by giving back a portion of his blessings.

*Psalm— **110 "Hallelujah, Praise Jehovah"**

We praise God for his many blessings that he has given in Christ.

God Speaks to Us Through His Word
