

The Triumphal Entry

When Jesus enters Jerusalem in what we call the ‘triumphal’ entry, we see the most deliberately choreographed event in his ministry.

This suggests to us the question: why was it so important to Jesus that he enter the city “on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a beast of burden?”

1. Jesus is our strong king

- a. From Damascus to Ekron *Zech. 9:1-8*
- b. Nothing and no one can stand against him

2. Jesus is our humble king

- a. He is the rightful king *Zech. 9:8*
- b. Who has come to serve us:
 - i. He will bring us peace *Zech. 9:8,10*
 - ii. He has come to set us free *Zech 9:11*
