The book of Hebrews challenges our more worldly concepts concerning what ‘church’ is and what church ‘does.’ We are not merely a social organization with an earthly mission, vision, or purpose. And primary among all our purposes is the mandate to worship the Living God.

1. Acceptably
 - a. What is unacceptable worship? Lev. 10:1; Amos 6:21-24
 - b. Acceptable content: the regulative principle
 - c. Acceptable conduct: ‘how’ we participate in worship John 4:23-24
2. With Reverence
 - a. A felt recognition of one’s relation to something superior
 - b. In worship, we come to something that
 - i. Cannot be touched
 - ii. Is unshakeable
3. With Awe
 - a. A joyful recognition
 - b. Of Christ’s work on our behalf
 - c. That is marked by gratitude
 - d. And is mindful of God’s holiness
