

The Transfiguration

The focus of Luke 9, from the sending of the Twelve to Peter's confession of Christ has been the identity and the mission of Jesus. The account of the Transfiguration provides us with the definitive conclusion to this question. Jesus is the 'Son of God, the Chosen One, and we are to listen to him.'

(verse 35)

1. Jesus is the Son of God
 - a. He is not merely 'Master'
 - b. He is not just another prophet
 - c. The glory of the transfiguration is 'his' *Ex. 34.29*
2. Jesus is the God's Chosen One *Hosea 11:1*
 - a. Jesus had an 'exodus' to fulfill
 - b. His mission is to free us from bondage - leaving Jerusalem!
3. Jesus is to be heard and obeyed
 - a. We can not be part time listeners
 - b. We often want to simply sit and listen
 - c. We must accept and act on all that Jesus says

Application:

1. Do we acknowledge Jesus as the Son of God?
2. Do we want to be delivered from the world and from our sins?

3. Will we listen to Jesus?
