*At CRPC we observe the Lord's Supper every Lord's Day as the climax of our covenant renewal worship. By partaking of the bread and wine with us, visitors acknowledge to the elders of our congregation that they are repentant sinners trusting in Christ alone for their salvation and are also communicant members in good standing of an evangelical church. If you have any doubt about your participation, please speak to a Pastor or an elder.*

**About the Cover ...** Alpha Omega

"Alpha" and "Omega" are the first and last letters of the Greek alphabet. This symbol originates from Revelation 22: 13: "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End" and underscores that Christ is eternal God and, as such, is the source and end of all things (i.e. Is. 41: 4; 44: 6; Rom. 11: 36; Rev. 1: 8, 17; 4: 8b; 21: 6).
