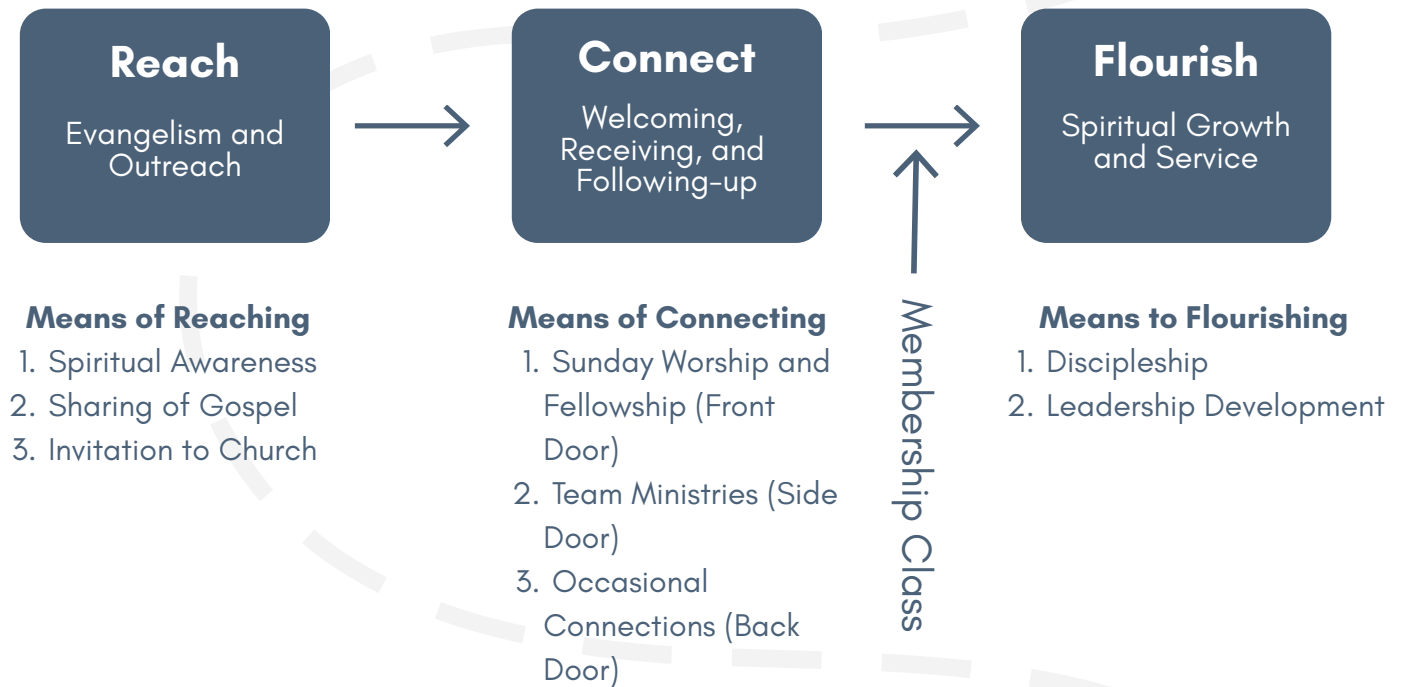

Our Discipleship Vision

Every Christian is a disciple of Jesus Christ. A disciple confesses the salvation and Lordship of Jesus (Romans 10:9-10) and seeks to obey his commands wholeheartedly (John 14:15).
