- If possible, bring a chair, an umbrella or other shade producing device, and a light-colored blanket to put on blacktop (it helps!)
- Consider spreading out to new areas of grass or shade around the parking lot area.
- During the service, individuals and family groups should keep 10-feet of social distance from others who are seated. When in conversation with others (encouraged!) keep 6-feet apart from one another. Masking is appropriate and encouraged.
