Confession of Sin

The honor which inferiors owe to their superiors is, all due **reverence** in heart, word, and behavior; prayer and thanksgiving for them; imitation of their virtues and graces; **willing obedience** to their lawful commands and counsels; **due submission to their corrections**; faithfulness to, defense, and care of their persons and authority, according to their several ranks, and the nature of their places; bearing with their infirmities, and covering them in love, that so inferiors may be an **honor** to them and to their governing.
