Question 139

What are the sins forbidden in the seventh commandment
(thou shalt not commit adultery?)

The sins forbidden in the seventh commandment are adultery, fornication, rape, incest, sodomy, and all unnatural lusts; all unclean imaginations, thoughts, purposes, and affections; all corrupt or filthy communications, or listening thereunto; wanton looks, immodest apparel; prohibiting of lawful, and allowing unlawful marriages; allowing, tolerating, keeping of prostitutes, and resorting to them; unwise vows of single life, undue delay of marriage, having more wives or husbands than one at the same time; unjust divorce, or desertion; unchaste company; lewd songs, books, pictures, dancing, stage plays; and all other encouragements to, or acts of sexual uncleanness, either in ourselves or others.
