Confession of Sin

O eternal God and merciful Father, we humble ourselves before your great majesty, against which we have frequently and grievously sinned. We acknowledge that we deserve nothing less than eternal death, that we are unclean before you and children of wrath. We continually transgress your commandments, failing to do what you have commanded, and doing that which you have expressly forbidden. We acknowledge our waywardness, and are heartily sorry for all our sins. We are not worthy to be called your children, nor to lift up our eyes heavenward to you in prayer. Nevertheless, O Lord God and gracious Father, we know that your mercy toward those who turn to you is infinite; and so we take courage to call upon you, trusting in our Mediator Jesus Christ, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world. Forgive all our sins for Christ’s sake. Cover us with his innocence and righteousness, for the glory of your name. Deliver our understanding from all blindness, and our hearts from all willfulness and rebellion, we pray through Jesus Christ, our Redeemer. Amen.

Westminster Larger Catechism Question 129

What is required of superiors towards their inferiors?

It is required of superiors, according to that power they receive from God to love, pray for, and bless their inferiors; to instruct, counsel, and admonish them; supporting, commending, and rewarding such as do well; and correcting, reproving, and chastising such as do ill; protecting, and providing for them all things necessary for soul and body: and by serious, wise, holy, and model behavior, to procure glory to God, honor to themselves, and so to preserve that authority which God has given them.

Westminster Larger Catechism Question 130

What are the sins of superiors?

The sins of superiors are, besides the neglect of the duties required of them, and too much seeking for themselves their own glory ease, profit, or pleasure; commanding things sinful, or not in the power of inferiors to do; counseling, encouraging, or supporting them in that which is evil; dissuading, or discouraging them in that which is good; correcting them excessively; carelessly exposing, or leaving them in wrong, tempting, and dangerous situations; provoking them to wrath; or any way dishonoring themselves, or lessening their authority, by doing something which is unjust, careless, severe, or negligent.
