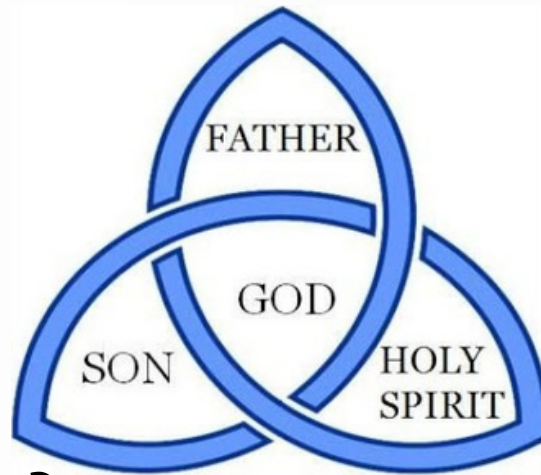

The Trinity

This month, we are focusing on the Trinity—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. It is a deep and sometimes challenging doctrine, and one I'd love for all of you to come to understand more fully. The Trinity is the central Christian belief that one God exists as three co-equal, co-eternal, and distinct persons: the Father, the Son (Jesus Christ), and the Holy Spirit. This Triune God is one in essence or being, but three in personhood. God the Father is the source and creator of all things. Jesus Christ, the Son, is eternally begotten—not created—and became human to redeem humanity. He is equal with the Father, yet distinct from Him. The Holy Spirit is the “Helper” or “Spirit of truth”, sent to guide and empower believers. This is a profound truth, and while it can be difficult to fully grasp, it helps us better understand who God is and how He works in our lives.
