**We welcome Mr. Ron Clegg of Southwood to our pulpit this morning.** Ron was born in Logan, WV. He graduated from Marshall University in 1976 with a B.A. degree in Rehabilitation Counseling. In 1978 he joined full time staff with Campus Crusade for Christ where he served with the Music Ministry in Atlanta, GA. In 1980 he left Campus Crusade to pursue theological education at Reformed Theological Seminary, Jackson, M.S. where he met his wife, Gayle. They were married August 21, 1982. From 1986 to 2000 Ron pastored churches in Eufaula, AL and Tifton, GA. He and Gayle joined World Harvest Mission/Serge in April 2000 to go to Budapest, Hungary where Ron served for six years as a teacher/discipler for church leaders, new church planters, and mission agencies in the Eastern European region. Upon returning from Hungary, Ron has served as the Sr. Pastor of Parkview Church in Lilburn, GA, and now serves as Assoc. Pastor for Discipleship at Southwood Presbyterian Church. The Cleggs have four grown children and 9 grandchildren.
