Why would God want you to pray? Let me give you just 10 of the many reasons why prayer is both commanded (I Thessalonians 5:17 pray without ceasing) and a blessing (Philippians 4:6-7 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.).



First, God wants to reinforce the concept that He is our true friend. Think for a moment of your earthly

friends. You enjoy talking with those friends. When that phone rings and the caller ID displays their name, with eagerness you quickly accept and talk to a friend you love. God wants that same type of relationship with you and one way to develop that relationship is through daily (and often) prayer.

Next, just like your parents here on earth, your Heavenly Father wants to hear from you and talk to you. When you pray, He listens. Then He answers your prayers in the form of deeper connections with His Word, the Bible, improved thoughts on your part, or even the actions of other Christians.

Third, prayer helps you gain an understanding of God's loving nature. The scriptures teach that God is love (I John 4:8). You can feel that love as you speak daily with Him through prayer, seeking His guidance in your life.

Fourth, prayer provides answers. Praying and listening to the answers God gives you can help you better understand your purpose in life. God will help you understand why you are here and what you can do to return to live with Him after this life.

Fifth, prayer helps you find direction in your life. When you pray to God, you can work through serious decisions in your life. God always listens and often provides the answers and guidance you seek. Even when He chooses not to answer

Immediately or in the way you might hope, prayer itself is a way to find the peace your soul needs.



God Gives Man the Choice

God allows us to live our lives how we want to. He gives us free will. He does not control every move that we make. We are not predestined individually to be saved or lost. They would be destroyed because they did not want to live by God's Word. He created all so He gets to make the rules.

He loves us and wants us to succeed, but if we do not listen to Him, punishment ensues. It is exactly like the relationship between a parent and their child. The child decides to disobey, and the parent brings punishment upon them. The parent does not hate their child, but they need to be taught and led in the right direction. Let us strive to do what is right in the sight of God!
