

# **Trusting the Process**

Moving is not fun. Not one bit. Even if it's just a move across town, the packing and loading, then the unloading and the unpacking, is tedious, hard work. To borrow an old expression, moving is "for the birds."

However, there are times when it is necessary to move from one location to another. While it's not fun, there is growth that occurs. While we are not always able to see it immediately, growth happens. I am confident that moving from

Fordland to Hot Springs will be a move that helps me and my family to grow. We will grow in love, in knowledge, in closeness with one another and with you all. We will grow together as a church family as we dig deeper into the Word of God. We will grow spiritually, and if we work and live as the early church did (if we look like that church), we will grow numerically as well! We must trust the process!

When we examine the scriptures, we see examples where it was necessary to trust the process of what God was trying to accomplish with His people. Think of Abraham in Genesis 12 when the Lord told him, "Now the LORD had said to Abram: "Get out of your country, From your family And from your father's house, To a land that I will show you. I will make you a great nation; I will bless you And make your name great; And you shall be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, And I will curse him who curses you; And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed." So Abram departed as the LORD had spoken to him, and Lot went with him" (Genesis 12:1-4a). Abraham (Abram) stumbled along the way, but by and large, he trusted God's process. As Abraham walked with God and kept His commands, his faith grew and as his faith grew, he grew closer to God.

When the Israelites left Egypt, theirs was an arduous refining process. It took 40 years for them to be molded and shaped into a people ready to enter the land that had been promised all those hundreds of years beforehand. They fell short on numerous occasions. The process took a long time. Eventually, though, they were able to enter the promised land when they had learned to trust the process of the Lord. (See Exodus through Joshua)

When the apostles sat at the feet of Jesus for three and a half years, it was a process for them to wrap their minds around the idea of a spiritual kingdom vs. a physical one. Even as Christ died, the process was ongoing. The apostles were still learning and having to trust the process of God even after the resurrection, ascension, and establishment of the Lord's church in Acts 2. When we get to Acts 10, we find Peter having to learn that the Gospel is also meant for the Gentiles; it's not just for those of Jewish descent.

Here's the point...the process of growth is lifelong. Abraham, Peter, Moses, Joshua, the Israelites, David, Solomon, and a host of others continued to learn this lesson. They all had to change their ways of thinking about some things when confronted with the process of the Lord. They were all challenged. When we are challenged in such ways, may we trust God's process and make the changes in our own lives that help us to grow closer to Him!


