The passage always brought a smile to my face as a little boy as Jesus talked about taking a speck out of one's eye all the while having a plank in your eye. That absurd illustration reminds me today of those situations like the person who calls to complain about their 'gossipy' neighbor while gossiping themselves or the child that tells their parents that their sibling 'tattles' all the time.

Even as you read this, you're likely thinking of someone else who constantly points out faults in others instead of reflecting & correcting their own.

The question Jesus posed in Matthew 7:3-4 invites all of us to turn the spotlight INWARD. Instead of focusing on what's wrong with others, it's a call to examine our own lives, recognize our weaknesses, and identify the blind spots we often overlook.

It's tempting to critique those who criticize, to shame those who don't follow Jesus' teaching, but here's the irony: God hasn't appointed us to 'speck-pick' at speck-pickers. Jesus calls us to resist the urge to condemn others and instead focus on humbling working on ourselves.

You may wonder, "But what about others? Who's going to correct them?" The lesson may very well come from you – but not by poking at their faults but rather, by your true Christian EXAMPLE. By modeling real Christianity, you encourage them to make changes in their own lives.

Jesus isn't telling us to IGNORE the faults of others – especially if their actions harm themselves or others. Jesus is reminding us that obsessing over their flaws is counterproductive. Ultimately, their weaknesses are something God can and will handle.

Now, as I close out all my online Bible classes, it is our hope, it is our wish, it is our prayer that we all live for Jesus 24/7...may God bless YOU!
