These Christians study our auditorium class, plus additional notes I email them, on the Sunday AFTER it airs on Facebook. The struggle I have been facing was how to give both the Christians in India and our members here what they need, but then a line from a movie came to me.

"The needs of the MANY outweigh the needs of the FEW, or the one."

While it grieves me deeply not to be able to meet the needs of our members who don't have WIFI/smart phone or tablet, the needs of the MANY must be followed.

Thus, **BIBLE STUDY MADE EASY** will be an online daily 5-7 minute video. The online video will preview the next day's reading (e.g. the January 1 reading will air on December 31, the January 2 reading will air on January 1, etc.). These daily online videos will also feature the answers to the QUESTIONS for that particular day.

BIBLE STUDY MADE EASY will also be aided by a Wednesday ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSION CLASS in classroom #116 that will dig deeper into the readings plus this Wednesday class will also feature material on how to SHARE OUR FAITH WITH FAMILY & FRIENDS. If you have family & friends who are not NT Christians, this class is a MUST for you. This class will not be aired online.

Notebooks will be distributed on December 21 and 28 and a special preview of **BIBLE STUDY MADE EASY** will be presented as the auditorium class on December 28.

Now, as I close out all my online Bible classes, it is our hope, it is our wish, it is our prayer that we all live for Jesus 24/7...may God bless YOU!



Ephesians 6:10 - Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.

Historian Shelby Foote tells of a soldier who was wounded at the battle of Shiloh during the American Civil War and was ordered to go to the rear. The fighting was fierce and within minutes he returned to his commanding officer. "Captain, give me a gun!" he shouted. "This fight ain't got any rear!"

In Ephesians, Paul describes the armor that we should put on daily. Have you ever noticed that every part of the body is covered except for one? The back! The Lord didn't want us to run away and turn our back toward our enemy -- it would leave us vulnerable, with no armor to protect us against his attack! And just as a dog would when he senses fear, if we run from the enemy, he will relentlessly chase us until we are broken.
