

Today is our 81st day of **BIBLE STUDY MADE EASY!**

We are over 22% through the Bible readings! Let's celebrate the chronological journey and the progress we have made! Here's a pat on the back & a tip of my hat to all of you! I love you all so much!

Today we start the book of Joshua, which is the first of the Old Testament history books. With the burial of Moses, the focus of leadership falls upon Joshua, who will lead the Israelites into the Promised Land, the land first promised to Abraham about 700 years previously. Over the next 6 years the Israelites will conquer much of the Promised Land and will begin to occupy their tribal allotments. However, it will take many more years for the tribes to gain full control of the land and even then, many of the local inhabitants will never be driven out. These local inhabitants will infect Israel with SIN and a desire to be like them. This will eventually bring on the need for the JUDGES.

But for now, in our **BIBLE STUDY MADE EASY** readings this week the time has come for Joshua to mobilize the nation. Preparations for the conquest includes not only the formulation of military strategy but also rededication to God and the holy purposes for which battles will soon be fought.

In the midst of all the activity of a nation preparing for war is the fascinating account of a woman, a sinful harlot of Canaan, whose faith in the true God leads her to play a key role in the initial invasion and eventually a spot in the genealogy of Jesus' family tree. The books of Hebrews & James praises her for her faith!

The historical record of Joshua reveals that God has chosen a righteous and courageous leader for His people. Joshua is the forerunner of our TRUE LEADER, who leads us today from a life of sin to a life in preparation for eternity with God. That TRUE LEADER, Jesus, bears the Greek name which is equivalent to the Hebrew name Joshua (meaning 'God is Salvation'). I pray you benefit from our **BIBLE STUDY MADE EASY** readings this week.

Beginning April 1st, please join us for an additional opportunity of study in our **BIBLE STUDY MADE EASY** series as we gather together every Wednesday morning @10 in the big classroom (classroom #118) for a devotional worship service and Bible study using **BSME** material.
