The formula combines nine homeopathic active ingredients that have been recommended in France for decades.

This convenient first-approach option provides patients and health care professionals a way to manage arthritis pain and control it as soon as it appears. The safety profile allows for administration as soon as pain flares up. When taken at the onset of pain, it may reduce the need for higher doses of painkillers.

The quick-dissolving sublingual tablets may be used in conjunction with Boiron Arnicare Gel, Cream, or Ointment for spot treatment.

Additionally, Arnicare Arthritis may be used to relieve delayed onset of joint aches and pains from physical therapy and other types of activities recommended to patients suffering from arthritis or rheumatic pain.

Warnings

Ask a doctor before use in children under 18 years of age.

Directions

■ Adults 18 years of age and older: At the onset of symptoms, dissolve 2 tablets under the tongue and repeat, if needed, every 15 minutes for 3 more doses. Then dissolve 2 tablets under the tongue every hour until symptoms improve.

■ do not use if glued carton end flaps are open or if the blister seal is broken ■ store at 68-77° F (20-25° C)
