Lowe-Gomez Scholarship Fund

This scholarship is for intellectually gifted students with financial need in grades 6 through 12 who reside in Rutherford, Cannon, DeKalb or Wilson Counties.

How it Works:

The scholarship can provide funds for students to attend academic programs (such as those currently offered by the Duke University Talent Identification Program including dual college-high school enrollment opportunities), summer and other short-term programs at institutions of higher learning. Additionally, it can provide financial assistance for such students to take qualifying entrance exams to institutions of higher learning such as the SAT or ACT exams.

When can I apply?

There are two rounds annually to apply and be considered for this funding. For Summer programming students need to apply by March 15th and for Spring programming the deadline to apply is September 15th.

Where do I get the application?
