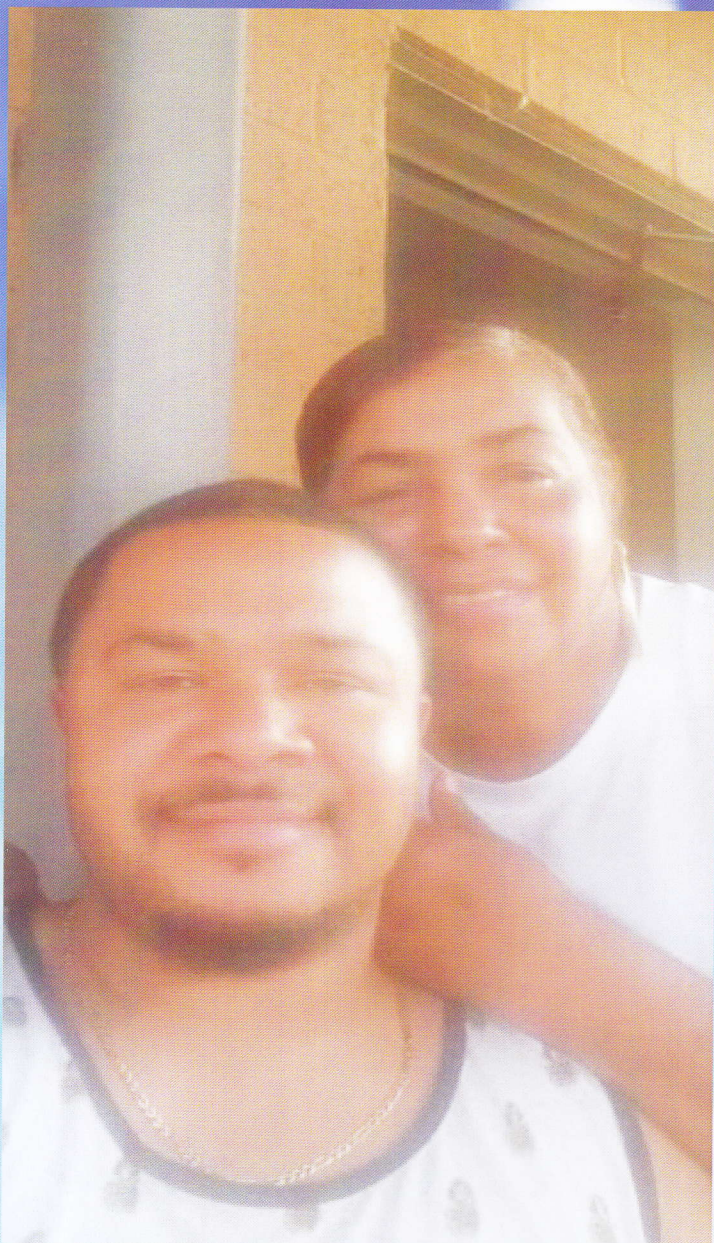

A special Son

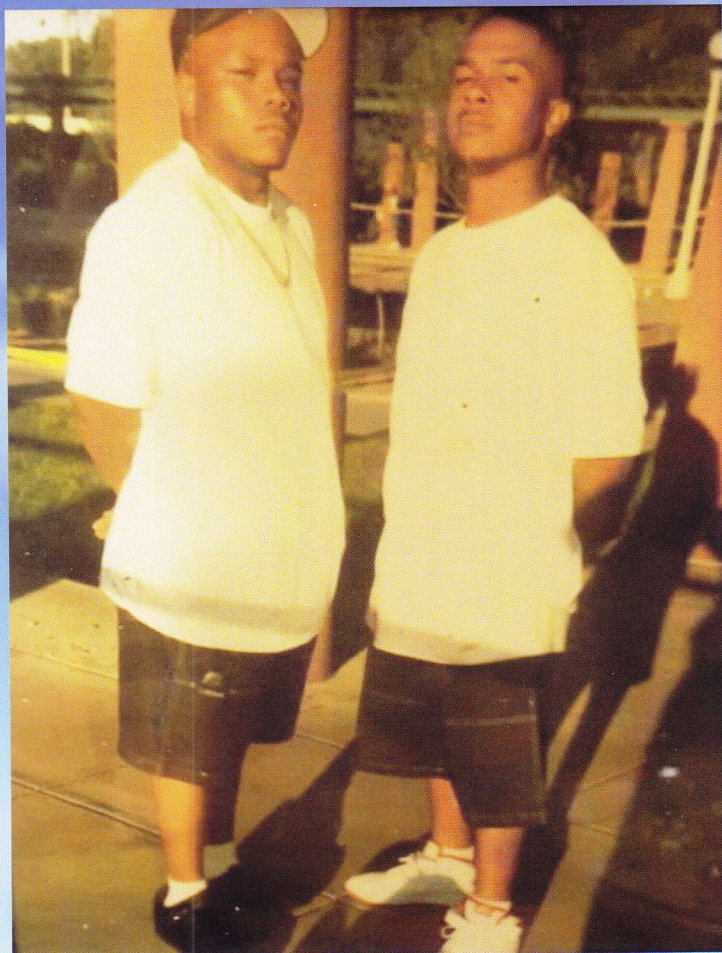

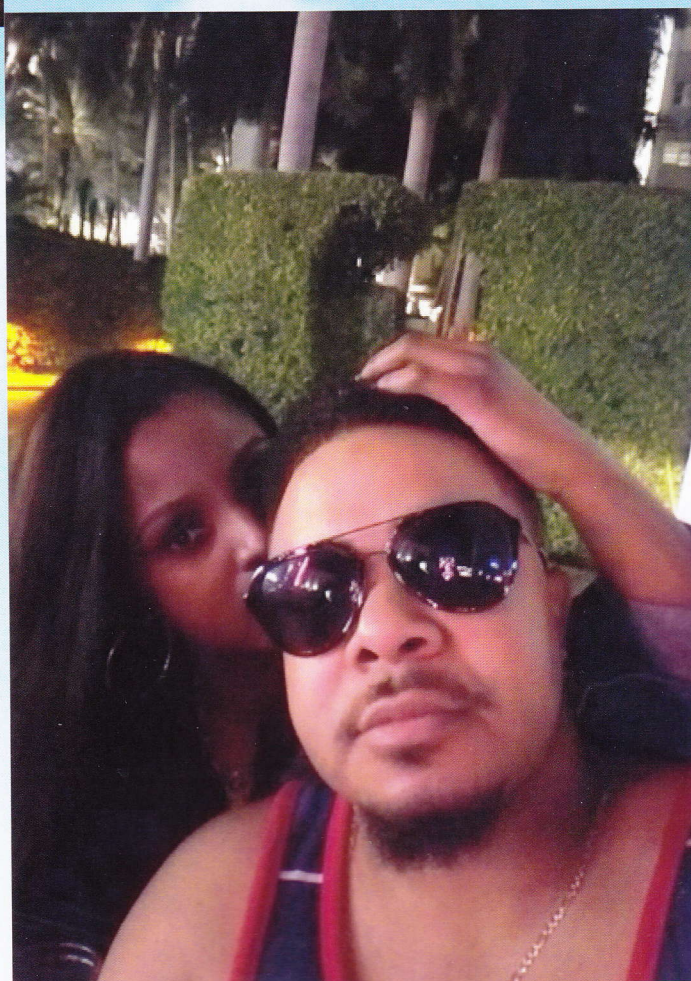
Brousin

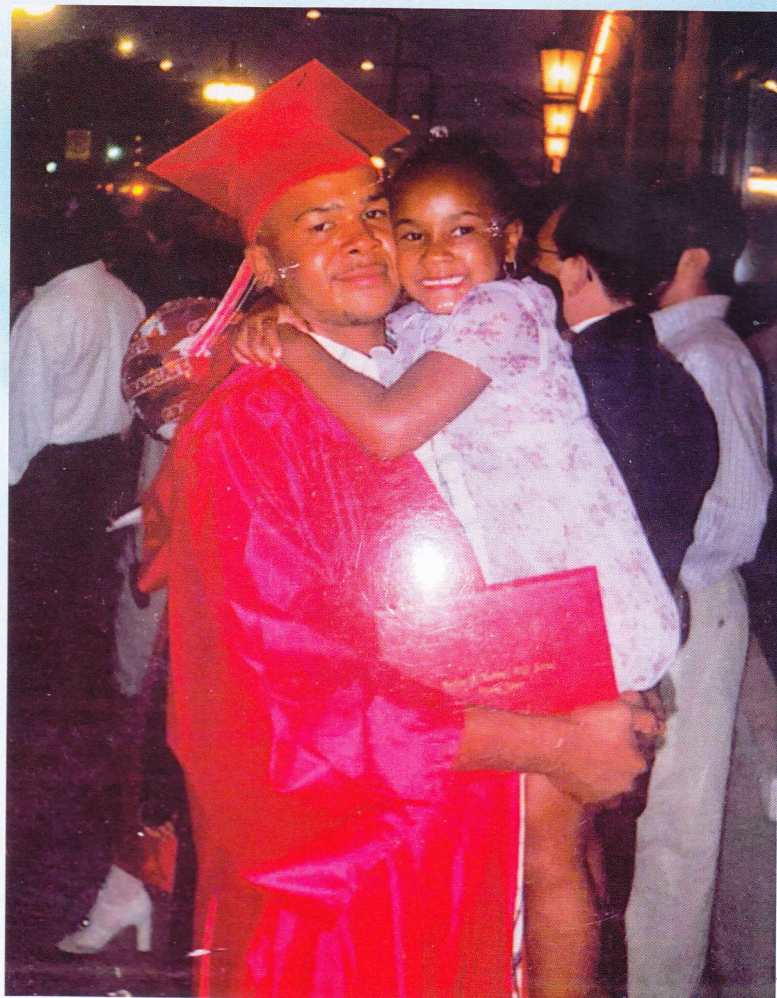


TO THE BEST DAD EVER
