GENERAL PRICE LIST

These prices are effective October 1, 2025 and are subject to change without notice.

A list of funeral costs is mandated by the FTC. Every funeral home is required to make this list available upon request for comparison by the consumer. This list has been simplified for this purpose.

The goods and services shown below are those that we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the services you desire. However, any and all funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services. This fee is the only non-declinable fee on the list. This list does not include items that we may offer or that you may request us to pay for you. These include cash advance items such as cemetery fees, minister, flowers, death certificates, final date lettering, etc.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FEE

BASIC SERVICES OF THE FUNERAL DIRECTOR.....2195

This fee for our services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This charge includes, but is not limited to: availability of staff on a 24 hour/day basis; initial family conference to determine services needed; obtaining, preparing and filing of necessary paperwork and permits, certificates and insurance policy paperwork and obituary; coordinating providers of outside services; safety and licensing requirements mandated by the state and government agencies; general business administration and record keeping.

EMBALMING.....795

Except in certain cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming is necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral or visitation with viewing of the decedent. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as a direct cremation or an immediate burial.

This fee includes the dressing, cosmetizing and casketing of the body.
