We offer the following services:

Pet Retrieval Service

We will gladly pick up your pet from your home and hold them in our care until the time of cremation or personal memorial service is complete.

Private Cremation

A private cremation means your pet is placed in a partitioned cremation chamber separate from other pets. Upon completion of the cremation, your pet's cremated remains are removed from the chamber and you are ensured of receiving only your pet's cremated remains in an urn of your choice.

The Love of Animals

Any animal that is loved by you is deserving of being honored in death. Domestic animals up to 250lbs are accepted with the dignity that they deserve.
