DECORATIVE AND FLORAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The beauty and serenity of this cemetery can only be sustained through proper maintenance. Adherence to the floral regulations better enables the attainment of that goal while also ensuring a safe work environment for our ground's crews and visitors. Any special arrangements made with previous office staff is expected to adhere to the following regulations.

1. Funeral flowers, holders, containers, baskets and easels will be removed between the first and second week following the funeral service, depending on the condition of the flowers. Any items desired by the family to be kept should be taken from the graveside after the service.
2. Other than at the actual time of the funeral, wreaths, easels, baskets, and potted plants are not permitted at any time. Special occasion arrangements are permitted from no sooner than one week prior to, and no longer than one week after, the occasion.
3. Glass containers, tin cans, plastic containers, concrete or any other type of planters are not permitted at any time. Cemetery issued bronze, steel, or granite vases, are permitted, depending upon the burial garden.
4. Grave decorations must not interfere with cemetery operations or maintenance. The Management reserves the right to regulate the method of decorations of lots so that uniform beauty may be maintained. The use of boxes, shells, toys, metal designs, pinwheels, ornaments, shepherd hooks, vigil lights, statues, benches, glass or crockery jars and containers, wood or metal cases, etc., shall not be permitted on any grave, lot or tree and such articles shall be removed and disposed of by the Management. Any flags placed on graves must be in the flower vase.
5. Evergreen blankets or coverings are not permitted at any time. The planting of live flowers, shrubs or trees is not permitted at any time.
6. Fresh cut flowers and artificial floral arrangements may be placed on the graves in approved containers throughout the year. Floral items will be removed from graves as soon as they become faded or unsightly and will be disposed of immediately. The digging of holes for any purpose whatsoever and placing of artificial flowers in the ground is strictly forbidden.
7. While cemetery employees will take care not to damage any grave decorations, we regret that we cannot guarantee that all decorations will remain free from damage or loss and the cemetery is not responsible for any items, personal or decorative, left at the cemetery or on gravesites.
8. To ensure proper maintenance of the grounds, the cemetery will facilitate a seasonal cleanup period occurring twice a year, one April and one in October (exact dates to be to be announced by cemetery).

The Cemetery Management expressly reserves the right, at any time and without prior notice to any owners, to adopt new regulations or to amend, modify, or repeal any section, paragraph or sentence of these regulations.
