

**GENERAL PRICE LIST**

These prices are effective as of 06/01/2020.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Prior to drafting any contract for goods or services, the responsible party or the decedent's survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements is entitled to receive a copy of any preneed agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in full or in part, by or on behalf of the decedent.

**Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff and Overhead. \$700**  
 Our services include: conducting the arrangements conference; planning the funeral; consulting with family and clergy; shelter of remains; preparing and filing of necessary notices; obtaining necessary authorizations and permits; coordinating with the cemetery, crematory, or other third parties. In addition, this fee includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

**Embalming . . . . . \$695**  
 Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

**Other Preparation of the Body . . . . . \$300**  
 Transfer of Remains to the Funeral Home (within 30 mile radius) . . . \$750  
 beyond this radius we charge \$4 per mile  
 Use of Facilities and Staff for Viewing. . . . . \$400  
 Use of Facilities and Staff for Funeral Ceremony at the Funeral Home. \$400  
 Use of Facilities and Staff for Memorial Service at the Funeral Home. \$400  
 \*If other church or chapel is used for service there may be some donation required at the church or chapel.

**Forwarding of Remains to another Funeral Home. . . . . \$2,445**  
 Our charge includes: basic services of funeral director and staff; a proportionate share of overhead costs; removal of remains; embalming or other preparation of remains, if relevant; and local transportation.

**Receiving Remains from another Funeral Home . . . . . \$2,100**  
 Our charge includes: basic services of funeral director and staff; a proportionate share of overhead costs; care of remains; transportation of remains to funeral home and to cemetery or crematory.

**Direct Cremation. . . . . \$1650 to \$2,445**  
 Our charge for a direct cremation(without ceremony)includes: basic services of funeral director and staff; a proportionate share of overhead costs; removal of remains; transportation to crematory; necessary authorizations; and cremation if relevant.

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The container we provide corrugated fiberboard container.

A. Direct cremation with container provided by the purchaser. . . . . \$1650  
 B. Direct cremation with a fiberboard container. . . . . \$1700  
 C. Direct cremation with NOLAN cremation casket . . . . . \$2,445  
 \*Overweight fee: \$200(201 lb.-250 lb.), \$400(251 lb.-300 lb.), \$600(301 lb ~400 lb), over 300 lb may require special container(air tray).

**Immediate Burial. . . . . \$1950 to \$2,845**  
 Our charge for an immediate burial (without ceremony) includes: basic services of funeral director and staff; a proportionate share of overhead costs; removal of remains; and local transportation to cemetery.
