- Initial Transfer includes vehicle, trained staff and specialized equipment used to transfer the deceased into our care from the place of death or Coroner's Office, hospital, nursing home, airport etc., within 70 kms of the Funeral Home. **Additional fees may apply for transportation outside the 70km radius.**

✓ **Minimum preparation of remains** \$ 50.00

- This service is a minimum requirement. The deceased is checked for personal effects (which are returned to the authorized representative unless otherwise instructed), and placed in the final container of choice (casket or cremation container).
- Includes the minimum preparations to get the deceased ready for a private viewing before delivery to place of service or final disposition, including but not limited to; bathing, setting features, dressing, placing on a hospital bed, gowning, placing a blanket or jewelry etc.

Funeral Coach

Transport Remains to Crematorium

- Flat rate that includes staff and vehicle to deliver the deceased to the crematorium and then to retrieve the cremated remains from the crematorium when they are ready at a later date. \$ 350.00

Refundable Deposit for Cremated Remains \$ 350.00

- When human remains are to be cremated, payment of a refundable deposit may be required. If the cremated remains are not claimed within one year of the cremation, the deposit may be used to inter the cremated remains in common ground in a cemetery of the funeral home's choosing. If the cremated remains are claimed before they are interred, the deposit will be refunded.

Removal of pacemaker or implant

\$150.00

- This procedure is mandatory prior to cremating a deceased that has a pacemaker or other implant and must be carried out by a licensed funeral director. This fee includes the disposal of the device.
- If the deceased was undergoing brachytherapy (radioactive theraseeds) or radioisotope treatments before death, it is possible that the deceased may not be eligible to be cremated. Please speak to one of our licensed staff for more information.

Professional restorative procedures

\$250.00

- In some circumstances, additional restorative efforts beyond those captured in the standard embalming procedure are necessary to enhance the appearance of the deceased. In such cases, the funeral director will discuss the available options and their cost. Professional restorative procedures will be charged per hour.

Jewelry

Our jewelry selection is constantly changing to meet the needs and desires of the community.

Our jewelry comes from Joyal and Allard and is made of stainless steel to protect a small portion of your loved one's cremated remains so that you may keep a piece of your loved one with you at all times.

All jewelry includes a box to keep the piece safe as well as a chain of varied style. All jewelry is \$95 +HST. This price includes placing the cremated remains in the necklace.

Disbursements

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by us. You are expected to pay for these items at the time the contract is entered into. The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements. Disbursements are exactly what the charge is, and there is no mark up for these services.

Coroner's fee – this is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario. The current amount is \$75.00

Clergy honorarium – this is an amount paid to the clergy for their services. In some cases the amount is set by the clergy. The standard amount is \$250.00

Newspaper or radio notices – these are charges for death notices placed in newspapers or radio or other media outlets.

The Manitoulin Expositor charges \$77.21 for a notice with a photo. Newspapers in Sudbury and beyond could cost upwards of \$250 to \$400 for a single notice.

Municipal death registration fee – this is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality and may vary. For Gore Bay the fee is \$10.00

Lowering Device- This fee is charged by the company we have arranged to provide the lowering set-up at a grave side service. The current rate is \$367.25

Cremation- We will arrange cremation with any crematorium, but we suggest Cooperative Crematorium in Chelmsford. We are proud to have a good working relationship with Cooperative. The current fee there is \$745.00

Cemetery Grave Opening/Closing Fees- These are fees set by the individual cemeteries and include the cost of arranging to have the grave dug and then filled in after the service. This fee varies greatly from cemetery to cemetery.

Payment, financing and funding

We are proud to offer various payment, funding and financing options to our clients.

Payment

The purchaser agrees to pay the amount owing within 30 days, after which interest will be calculated and charged on any overdue amount at the rate of 1.5% per month (equivalent to 18% per annum) until the date payment is made in full. A fee of \$45 will be added to the contract amount for any non-sufficient funds (NSF) cheques we receive.

Financing

Our payment plans give you the option of making payments over time. We offer a variety of payment plans to meet your financial needs.

Funding

When prepaying, you pay for the services and supplies today and the money will be used to pay for the services and supplies when they are delivered at the time of death.

Trust: You may pay the money directly to us and we will place it in trust, where it will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered) or the contract is cancelled.

Insurance: You may purchase an insurance contract where the proceeds of the insurance contract will be used to pay for the services or supplies at the time they are delivered.
