
Please note the rental casket has been used before, and may be used again and are for cremation only. A new rental liner and interior is used for each deceased.







Payment [Variable]

Unless otherwise specified, a deposit of 50% is required on the day of signing the contract. Balance is due within 30 days of signing the contract. Payment may be made by cash, cheque, debit, and most major credit cards. Beyond the allotted time, interest can be charged at a rate of 1.5% per month, which is equivalent to 18% per annum (APR).

If you are prepaying for services or supplies, pre-authorized chequing is also available.

Financing (Pre-arrangements only)

Our payment plans give you the option of making payments over time. We offer a competitive financing program, administration fees and interest rates.

Funding (Pre-arrangements only)

For your convenience, we offer two funding options when prepaying services or supplies. When prepaying, you pay for the services and supplies today and the money will be used to pay for the services and supplies when they are delivered at the time of death.

Trust: Money is directed into a individual trust, where it will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered) or the contract is cancelled.

Insurance: You may purchase an insurance contract where the proceeds of the insurance contract will be used to pay for the services or supplies at the time they are delivered or the contract is cancelled.
