PAYMENT

Payment is due in full at time of arrangement conference. An 8% processing fee shall be added to the total contract for an assignable insurance policy upon verification. There is a minimum processing fee of \$200.00 on policies \$2,000 or less. Prices listed on the General Price List are for payments made by cash, money order, or cashier's check.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

The goods and services shown below are those we provide to our customers. You may choose only those items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a non-declinable charge for our basic service and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must purchase any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

A. Basic Services of Funeral Director & Staff \$ 1,200.00

Includes the services of funeral director and staff during business hours to respond to initial request for service, arrangement conference, planning of funeral or memorial service; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; assisting with placement of obituary notices; receiving and arrangement of flowers; sheltering of deceased; overhead expenses for funeral home operation i.e. 24 hour response to calls, billing and accounting, administrative costs, maintenance and utility expenses, equipment and inventory expenses. This fee of our basic services of funeral director and staff will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. It is already included in our charges for direct cremations, Immediate burials, and receiving or forwarding remains.

B Embalming \$495.00

Except in certain cases, **embalming is not required by law**. However, embalming may be necessary if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. Instances where embalming is required are such as where the remains are to be transferred out of the state or country.

California law requires that when a deceased is held at any facility for a period of 24 hours that embalming or refrigeration must take place. CA Code of Regulations 1233c
