Minimum Cremation Service **\$ 895.00**

Includes the following items: Transfer of Remains (*within Sedgwick County*), Minimum Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff, *Sedgwick County Coroner's Permit to Cremate Fee (\$50.00)*, Placing of Remains in Cremation Container, Cremation, Utility Urn.

(If Coroner's Permit Fee is more than \$50.00 and additional charge will be applied)

Basic Services of Funeral Director/Staff**\$ 2,725.00**

Our charge includes funeral counseling, necessary arrangements, recording vital statistics, securing permits, filing and obtaining death certificates and other forms and claims, preparation of necessary notices and coordination of service plans with parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangement you select.

(This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving of remains.)

Embalming**\$ 1,100.00**

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as *Direct Cremation or Immediate Burial*.

Forwarding of Remains: This charge includes removal of remains (*within Sedgwick County*), basic services of staff, necessary authorizations, embalming, local transportation and Combo Unit/Casket Air-Tray. **\$ 4,925.00**

(This charge does not include airline fees, visitation or ceremonies before forwarding of the remains.)

Receiving of Remains: This charge includes local receiving of remains, basic services of staff, necessary authorizations and local transportation to cemetery. **\$ 4,225.00**

(This charge does not include visitation or ceremonies before burial of the remains.)

Direct Cremation: (Prices range from \$ 895.00 to \$ 9,390.00)

Our charge for this service includes removal of remains (*within Sedgwick County*), care of remains, minimal basic services of staff, transportation to crematory, obtaining necessary authorizations and permits (*\$50.00 allowance for Coroner's Permit*), utility urn. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (*with or without an outside covering*).

The containers we provide are cardboard. *(This charge does not include viewing or ceremonies before cremation.)*

Direct Cremation with container provided by purchaser (or our minimum cardboard container) **\$ 895.00**

Direct Cremation with Harmony (blue cloth/ivory crepe) basic cremation container. **\$ 2,135.00**

Direct Cremation with selected Casket/Cremation Container (plus price of the selected casket/cremation container) **\$ 895.00**

Immediate Burial: (Prices range from \$3,700.00 to \$13,695.00)

Our charge for this service includes removal of remains (*within Sedgwick County*), basic services of staff, necessary authorizations, permits and local transportation to cemetery.

(This charge does not include cemetery charges, and if required, an outer burial container.)

Immediate Burial with container provided by purchaser. **\$ 3,825.00**

Immediate Burial with Bellevue (silver/white crepe, copper/rosetone crepe) 20 ga casket. **\$ 6,020.00**
