For over 90 years, we have faithfully served grieving families with the belief that they are entitled to the utmost in care, respect, and dignity during their most difficult time. The most effective way to cope with the death of a loved one is for family, friends, and community to gather together, sharing stories and offering love and support.

To honor this commitment, we place a staff of the finest, caring personnel at your service. We maintain outstanding facilities for the comfort of the families and their friends we serve. We work with you to personalize your arrangements so they are most meaningful to you, and encourage and welcome your thoughts and wishes.

We provide information to the community, at no charge and without obligation, so that all consumers can make informed and intelligent decisions about funeral care. As part of this effort, we provide this itemized price list to all parties who inquire about funeral arrangements.

The goods and services shown are those items that we can provide to the families we serve. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements dictate that you must buy any items you did not specifically request, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

We hope the information provided here will help you to have a complete understanding of the costs of any services you may desire. It is the goal of our staff to help you create a meaningful celebration of life that will suit your needs perfectly, and exceed your expectations.

Our History

Our grandfather, Louis M. Kfoury, began his funeral profession in 1932 in Lawrence, Massachusetts. Louis was 21 years old and the youngest Funeral Director in the area at the time.

In 1936, having established his reputation as a dignified, compassionate care-giver, and knowing that Boston was where he could best serve his growing number of client families, Louis moved the business to Boston's South End. At that time, most city funeral homes were merely storefronts, as the majority of funeral services took place in the family home or at a place of worship.

In 1937 Louis met Rose Haddad of West Roxbury. This meeting would be the beginning of four generations (and counting) of the Kfoury family in West Roxbury. Louis and Rose married in 1940, and had two sons, Louis Jr. and Ronald.

Louis was joined in the family funeral profession by our father, Louis M. Kfoury, Jr. in the mid 1960's. This was an exciting time for our Dad, who had recently married his high school sweetheart, Ann O'Flanagan, daughter of John and Mary (O'Hare), and remained in West Roxbury to raise his family. Louis Jr. and Ann married in 1966 and had two sons, Louis III and Richard.

By 1972 Louis recognized the need for a larger facility and a more central location, to best meet the needs of client families who were both growing in number and moving outside of the South End. That year Kfoury Funeral Home opened in a beautiful Victorian in Brookline, Mass., near the JFK Birthplace, and flourished in a location convenient to both the South End and to our many client families throughout Greater Boston.

Upon Louis' death in 1979, our Dad took over the business and carried it through the 1980's and 1990's. He quickly earned a reputation of compassionate and caring service, which allowed him to serve more and more new client families. It was during the mid 1990's that Dad was joined by his son, Louis III. This would prove to be the link in joining Dad's generation of service to the reputation which we uphold today.

Louis Jr. passed away in 2000. The Kfoury Funeral Service has continued to flourish under Louis III and Richard, who have earned their own reputation as dignified, compassionate care-givers, carrying on the tradition of service to families in need.

In 2003 the Keefe Funeral Home in West Roxbury, which had been established in 1946 by Francis T. Keefe, became the new home for the Kfoury family to carry on a commitment to compassionate service. In recognition of the fine reputation of Mr. Keefe, the Keefe name was maintained. Our beautifully-renovated funeral home is the fulfillment of a long-time dream of both our father and grandfather.

It will be our home for generations to come.

PACKAGES

One of our caring professionals will spend time with your family to learn about your loved one. Along with your family, we will help create a meaningful celebration of their life. We specialize in creating a warm, comfortable environment for your family and friends to gather in love and support. The following are three service packages which might meet your needs. No adjustment will be made for items not used. **These packages are only available to those families who purchase a casket and outer burial container from Kfoury Keefe Funeral Home.**

Complete Traditional Funeral Service

Our Traditional Funeral Service is for those who want all the services that are associated with a traditional funeral. There is one day of visitation with the body present; followed by a funeral service at the funeral home or off-site church or other location and burial at a local cemetery.

Our Traditional Funeral Service Package includes all of the professional services that are associated with a traditional funeral. All necessary services of the funeral director and funeral staff for removal from local place of death, embalming, other preparation of the body, preparation and procurement of all necessary documents, such as death certificate and burial permit, use of the funeral home or use of staff for off-site visitation, use of the funeral home for funeral service or use of staff for funeral off-site, and hearse to local off-site funeral and/or cemetery. This charge does not include the casket and other merchandise you choose from our selection, or cash advances. \$5,995.00.

Memorial Service

A Memorial Service occurs following burial. The service itself can be customized to the wishes of the family, and often includes flowers, photos, recorded music, and reflections by family and friends.

Our Memorial Service Package includes all of the professional services for a Simple Burial with no visitation or viewing, followed by a memorial service, either at the funeral home or off-site. All necessary services of the funeral director and staff for removal from local place of death, preparation and procurement of all necessary documents, such as death certificate and burial permit, minimum washing/disinfection of the body, hearse to local cemetery, use of the funeral home for memorial service or use of staff for off-site service, and limousine for the memorial service. This charge does not include the casket and other merchandise you choose from our selection, or cash advances. \$2,995.00.

Simple Burial

A Simple Burial includes no visitation.

Our charge for a Simple Burial includes all of the professional services for local removal and shelter of remains, preparation and procurement of all necessary documents, such as death certificate and burial permit, minimum washing/disinfection of the body, transportation to local cemetery, and graveside service. This charge does not include the casket and outer burial container you choose from our selection, or cash advances. \$1,995.00.

Cremation can be part of the process of saying goodbye to a loved one. With this in mind, we offer the following **Cremation Service Packages**. No adjustment will be made for items not used. **These packages are only available to those families who purchase an urn and casket, if applicable, from Kfoury Keefe Funeral Home.**

Complete, Traditional Funeral Service followed by Cremation

Our Traditional Cremation Service is for those who want all the services that are associated with a traditional funeral, but without the expenses of a vault purchase or cemetery charges. There is one day of visitation at the funeral home with the casketed body present; followed by a funeral service at the funeral home or off-site church or other location, followed by cremation. At a later date, the cremated remains are delivered to the family. The remains can be kept in an appropriate urn, scattered, or buried at a cemetery.

Our Traditional Cremation Service Package includes all of the professional services that are associated with a traditional funeral. All necessary services of the funeral director and funeral staff for removal from local place of death, embalming, other preparation of the body, one day of visitation, use of the funeral home for funeral service or use of staff for funeral off-site, and hearse to off-site funeral and/or crematory. This charge does not include the casket, urn and other merchandise you choose from our selection, or cash advances such as crematory and medical examiner fees. \$5,995.00

Cremation followed by Visitation or Memorial Service

For this service package, cremation takes place first, followed by visitation or a memorial service, usually with the urn of cremated remains present. The service itself can be customized to the wishes of the family, and often includes flowers, photos, recorded music, and reflections by family and friends. This allows the family to save the traditional expenses of a casket, vault, and cemetery charges. Like the Traditional Service above, following the service the remains are taken by the family.

Our Memorial Service Package includes all of the professional services for a simple cremation, as described below, followed by a visitation or memorial service, either at the funeral home or off-site. All necessary services of the funeral director and funeral staff for removal from local place of death, preparation of the body for identification and cremation, pouch and cremation container required by the crematory, transportation to crematory, local delivery of cremated remains to family or staff for graveside service, use of the funeral home for visitation or memorial service, or use of staff for off-site service. This charge does not include the urn and other merchandise you choose from our selection, or cash advances such as crematory and medical examiner fees. \$2,995.00

Simple Cremation

A Simple Cremation includes no visitation or services.

Our charge for a Simple Cremation includes all of the professional services for local removal of remains, shelter of remains mandated by state law, preparation of the body for identification and cremation, procurement of death certificate and cremation permit, coordination with Office of the Chief Medical Examiner for cremation certification, cremation container required by crematory, transportation to crematory, and cardboard container for cremated remains. This charge does not include the urn you choose from our selection, or cash advances such as crematory, medical examiner, and permit fees. \$1,995.00

Services and Facilities

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND OVERHEAD. \$2,575

Our professional service charge includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service, arrangement conference with family or responsible party, arrangement of funeral, preparation and filing of necessary notices, authorizations and consents; and other services and attendance prior to, during and following the funeral, including coordinating with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g. cemetery, crematory, and others. Also included in this charge are overhead charges related to our facility such as insurance, maintenance and utility expenses. This basic charge does not include use of the facilities or staff for any visitation or funeral service. This fee for our services will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for simple cremations, simple burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.

EMBALMING. \$795

Embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement which does not require you to pay for it, such as a simple cremation or simple burial. For the protection of the public health, it is our policy to require embalming when a body is in our facility for 72 hours or more.

Simple Cremations

Our charge for a simple cremation, without any attendant rites or ceremonies, includes local removal and shelter of remains, preparation of the body for identification, transportation to crematory, and necessary services of staff. It does not include cash advance items, such as medical examiner fee, crematory charges, and permit. If you want to arrange a simple cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without outside covering). The containers we provide have a particleboard base and heavy cardboard sides and cover.

SHELTER OF REMAINS per 24-hour period.	\$150
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FORWARDING OF REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME. \$1995
This charge includes removal of remains, services of staff, embalming, minimum shipping container for body, necessary authorizations, and local transportation to Logan Airport. It does not include the services of staff or the use of facilities for any visitation and/or rites or ceremonies prior to forwarding the body. The cost of other than local transportation in vehicles of the funeral home is \$2.25 per mile over 10 miles.

RECEIVING OF REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME. \$1995
This charge includes temporary shelter of the remains, transportation of remains to cemetery or crematory and required services of staff. It does not include the services of staff or the use of facilities for viewing or for funeral rites/ceremonies.

SIMPLE BURIALS.from \$1995
Our charge for a Simple Burial includes all of the professional services for local removal and shelter of remains, preparation and procurement of all necessary documents, such as death certificate and burial permit, minimum washing/disinfection of the body, and transportation to local cemetery. This charge does not include a casket, outer burial container if required by the cemetery, or cash advances.

Simple burial with casket selected from our funeral home, in addition to the casket. . . . \$1995

Simple burial with minimum (cloth-covered) casket. \$2515

Simple burial with container provided by purchaser. \$1950

Weekend additional charge for any funeral rites or ceremonies, per day. \$500

Holiday additional charges: Martin Luther King Jr. Day, President's Day, Patriot's Day, Mother's Day, Memorial Day, Father's Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day. \$750

No funeral rites or ceremonies will be held on New Year's Day, Easter, Independence Day, Thanksgiving or Christmas.
