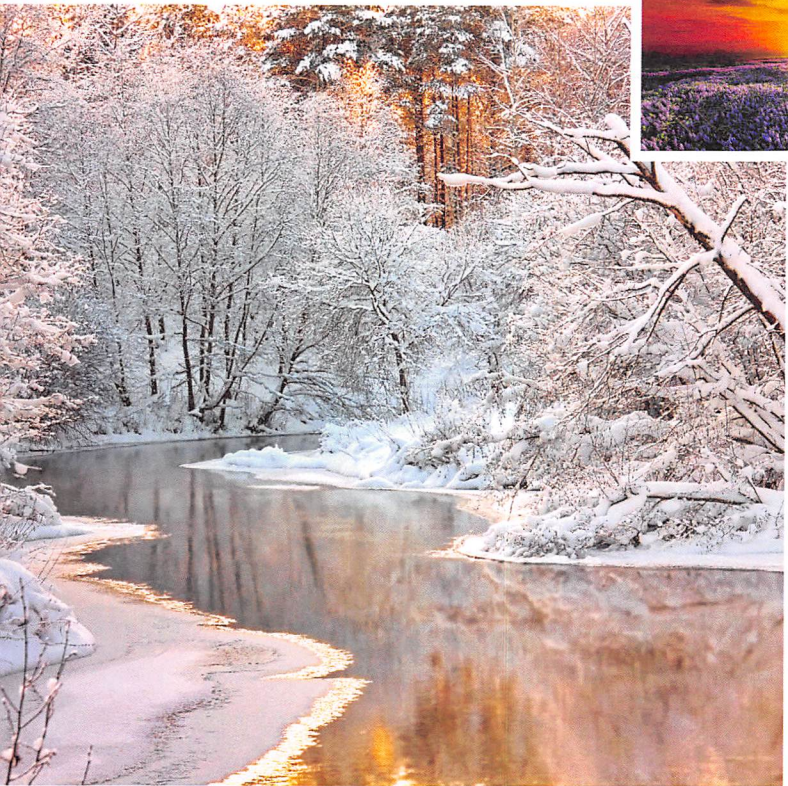
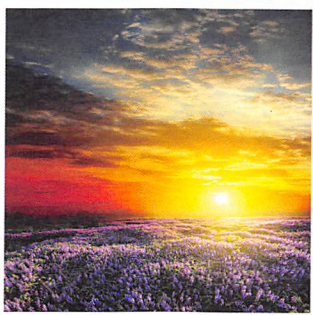
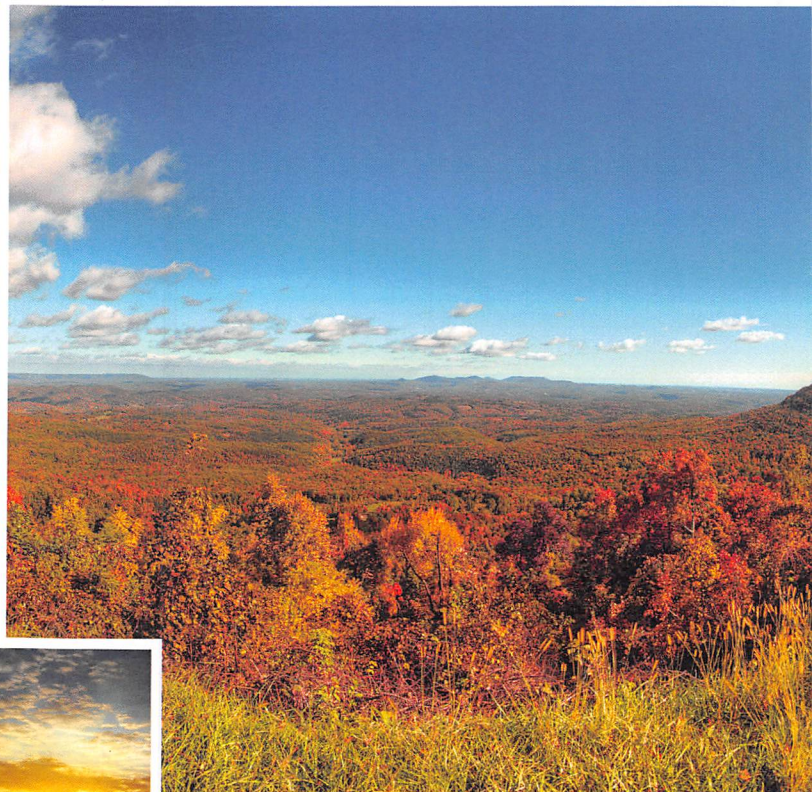


# PERSONAL PLANNING GUIDE
